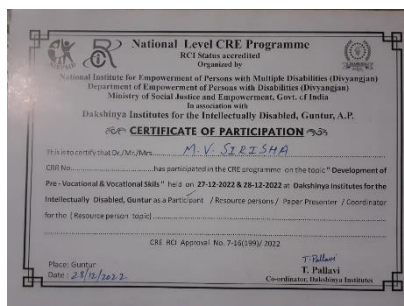
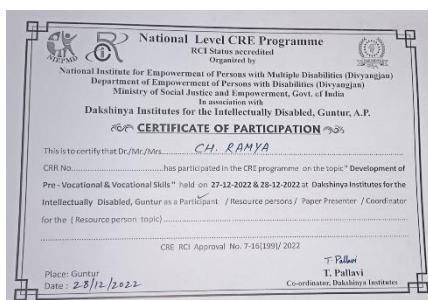
Awareness Programme on Waste Management (04.11.2022)
